## **2012 Quick Facts** Cosmetic and Reconstructive Plastic Surgery Trends

#### Percentage change 2012 vs. 2011

- **14.6 million cosmetic procedures 15%**
- 1.6 million cosmetic surgical procedures
- 13 million cosmetic minimally-invasive procedures 16%
- 5.6 million reconstructive procedures 1%

### 2012 Top 5 Cosmetic Surgical Procedures

Breast augmentation (286,000) Nose reshaping (243,000) Eyelid surgery (204,000) Liposuction (202,000) Eacelift (126,000)	2012 vs. 2011 ↓ 7% no change ↓ 4% ↓ 1% ♠ 6%

Breast augmentation continues to be the top cosmetic surgical procedure and has been since 2006. Silicone implants were used in 62%, and saline implants in 38%, of all breast augmentations in 2012.

Cosmetic surgical procedures, not among the Top 5, with notable gains in 2012 include:

- Male breast reduction (gynecomastia) up 5%
- Hair transplantation up 4%
- Upper arm lifts up 3% (and up a whopping 4,473% since 2000!)

Maxillofacial surgery (209,000)	17%
